Top Down Frameworks: Bottom Up Mobilization



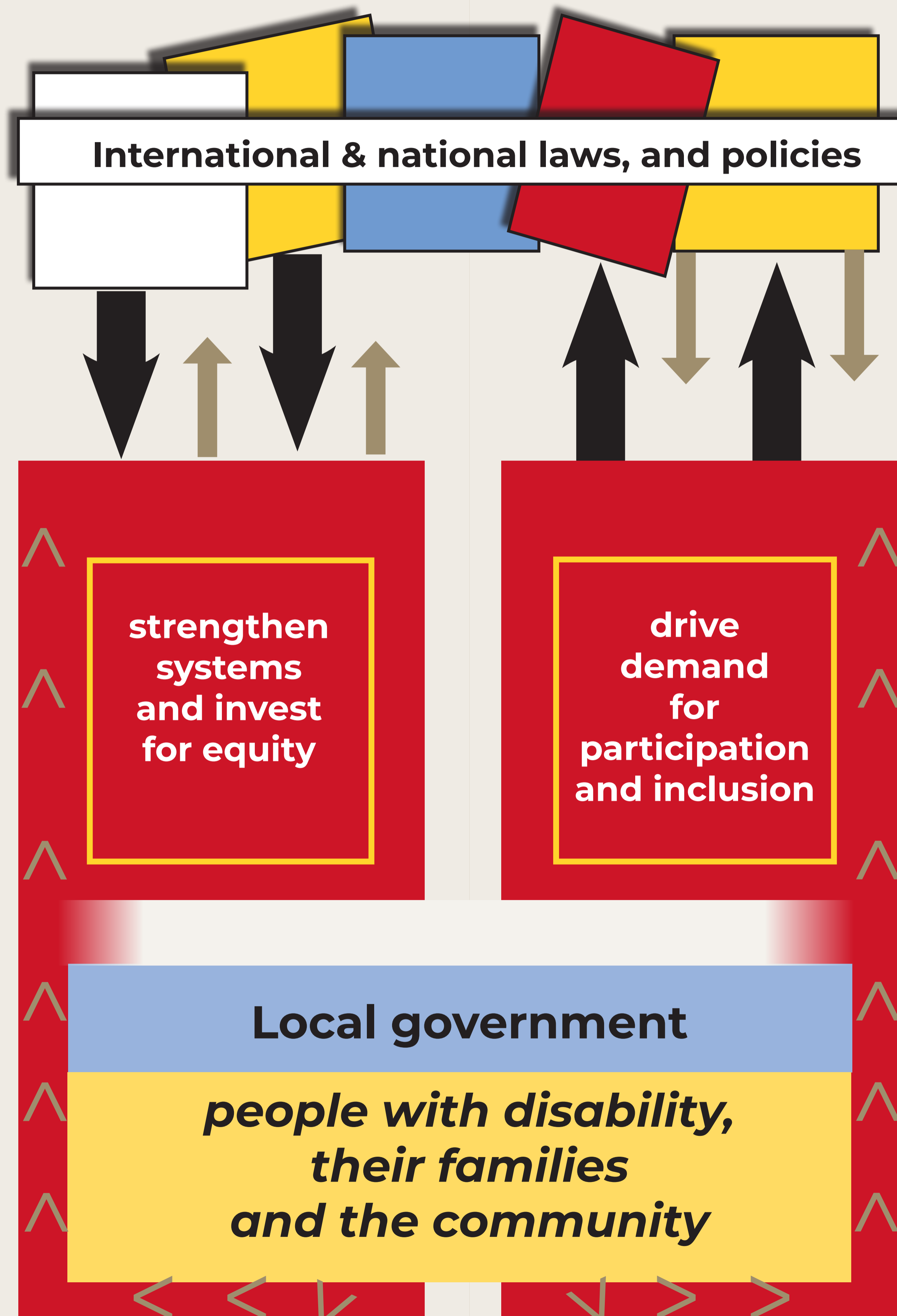
CBID happens differently according to the country context.

CBID could be initiated by:

- National government and government systems
- Local government
- Disabled People's Organizations (DPOs)
- Non Government Organizations (NGOs)

However CBID happens, it involves both national frameworks and community mobilization processes.
